UNIDO ITPO Italy — the Italian Investment and Technology Promotion Office of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization — organizes the "Kenya Renewable Energy Bootcamp": a four-day training session with Italian experts focused on geothermal energy in Kenya, which on 11th and 12th July 2023 will be open to the public and take place respectively at the Strathmore University in Nairobi (Ole Sangale Road, off Langata Road, in Madaraka Estate, Nairobi) and the KenGen Olkaria Geothermal Spa (47PW+W2W, Olkaria Route). On 13th and 14th July, the Italian experts recruited by UNIDO ITPO Italy will continue their training activities at the Geothermal Development Company in Nakuru for GDC staff.

As a follow-up to the multiple activities carried out by UNIDO ITPO Italy in the field — among which its <u>technical mission to Kenya in March 2023</u> and its "Italy-Kenya Business & Investment Forum on Geothermal" — several areas have been indicated as key to further develop this sector, including the need to focus on the education and training of professionals.

Notably featuring the participation as mentors of 9 Italian experts representing the main public and private stakeholders in geothermal energy at national level, the Bootcamp is dedicated to Kenyan professionals in the field to facilitate the exchange of know-how and best practices between the two countries, in order to bridge the gap and accelerate Inclusive and Sustainable Industrial Development in the geothermal sector of Kenya.
